





















BIESSING OF THE BACKPACKS







Week before

- Print off the sheet of tags according to how many you need
 - 2. Cut around the border for each tag
- 3. Get each student to design and colour each tag to their own taste.
- 4. Once coloured and designed to liking, laminate tags and hole punch in the circle.
- 5. Attach a piece of string (or alternative) through the hole that can then be added to backpack of student after blessing.
- 6. Ask children/youth to bring bags to church next Sunday

- 3. Hand out laminated tags either attach to bags or get parents to help attach later.
