NATIVITY PLAY for younger children

CHARACTERS

Have all characters seated in a line. When it's time for a child to read their part, they stand and remain standing for the duration of the play. The beauty of this script is that each child only has one line to learn, which is repeated throughout the story.

The 'Dog' could be any animal – an ox would work well – but we had a little girl who desperately wanted to dress up as a dog, and a dog costume was easier than an ox! Feel free to substitute an animal of your choice.
