

On the 3rd June 2017, The Vahefonua Sunday School held a one day Workshop for the Sunday School Teachers from all twenty congregations within the Auckland Region at Otahuhu Church (Fuakava Taengata 'o Kenani). This Workshop was run by the Sunday School Curriculum Committee and each member was given a class level to work with other Sunday School Teachers who are currently teaching in these levels within their own congregations, from Kindy to Class Six which are the older teenage students.

The purpose of this Workshop is to help train the Sunday School Teachers, on new strategies and techniques on how to teach aspects of the curriculum. Finding better and interesting, effective ways on teaching strategies that will help our students understand and learn aspects of the Curriculum. We look at what types of resources that we can use and this is important with our lower levels from Kindy to class three students.
